- 5.) What Port facilities most concern your group?
- 6.) What do you think are the top 3 priorities facing the Port today?
- 7.) What factors should the Port use to measure success in 5 years?
- 8.) What one question would you like the Port to answer?
- 9.) Have we missed any groups you believe should be represented?
- 10.) How should the Port and consultant team keep your stakeholder group informed and engaged during the process?
- 11.) Which two people in your stakeholder group would you nominate to serve on the Citizen's Advisory Committee?
