

Jefferson County International Airport Taxiway and Hangar Development Project

This project is a very important part of the Port of Port Townsend's Jefferson County International Airport (JCIA), 20-year visioning document, the Airport Master Plan. This Master Plan was a 2-year intensive planning process involving stakeholders and the community at large. It was approved and adopted in December of 2003 by the Port's Board of Commissioners and continues to be the driving document with regards to development at JCIA.

- Total cost of this public / private partnership is slated to be approximately \$7.5 million with most of that money coming from hangar sales, grants and development fees.
- This project has been partially funded through a \$1.7 million FAA Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grant.
- Taxiways and construction pads will accommodate up to 65 new hangar spaces in various configurations.

- Taxiway and infrastructure construction provided by Seton Construction of Port Townsend, WA.

This project is scheduled to be complete in the summer of 2009: Taxiways and hangar pads to be completed in September 2007, with most hangars built out by the summer of 2009. A limited number of hangars should be coming on-line spring of 2008.
